SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The following is a list of our school rules and regulations. Every student joining the school should read them thoroughly and then sign the declaration in part F of the admission form. The parent/Guardian should also sign the declaration.

Introduction

Discipline is paramount in any organization if the set organization goals have to be achieved. In our school a set of rules and regulations is usually provided to guide students in maintaining a high level of discipline, which actually leads to academic excellence.

Sunday Service:

The Sunday service is an interdenominational one. All students are expected to attend the service which is also a school programme.

- 1. Every student will follow the laid down routine. punctuality must be observed at all times for;
 - > Assemblies.
 - Lessons, Preps
 - > Games
 - Church Services
 - > Entertainments E.T.C.
- 2. Every student will be expected to be engaged in all school activities. A student will only be exempted from any activity only when the teacher concerned is satisfied that the student's condition warrants such exemption or has a medical document indicating that she should be exempted.
- 3. Every student will be in school uniform throughout the school term. uniform should be;
 - Clean and not torn.
 - ➤ Worn both in school and outside the school.

Hair should be

- > Neat and straight.
- ➤ No curly kit
- > No tinted hair or blowouts

- ➤ No set perms.
- > Hair ribbons should be black only
- > No other hair accessories.

No student will bring into the school compound any item of clothing that is not school uniform. For cold weather Maroon Fleece jackets, scarves and leg-warmers will be allowed. Neither jewelery nor makeup is permitted. Nail polish on the nails and long nails are strictly prohibited. Black low-heeled leather shoes should be worn with white socks.

4. Students shall show respect to all persons in the school compound including teachers, visitors, fellow students and any other members of staff in the school. Instructions from prefects and class monitors will have to be obeyed.

- 5. Students will be expected to behave themselves with decorum during school outings either as a member of a school sports team or as a member of a club/society on an official outing. Any kind of misbehavior reported to the school will be strictly dealt with.
- 6. Every student will be expected to remain in the school compound. Before leaving the compound **WRITTEN PERMISSION** except on closing or Midterm days will have to be obtained and student I.D. presented at the gate.
 - When written permission is obtained the student will report to the Deputy Principal on returning to school. Any student who does not report back as per the time MUST be accompanied by the parent/Guardian.
- 7. Permission will not be given for such functions as Graduations, Weddings, Birthday Party's etc. N.B: Overnight permission i.e. to be away from school for at least one day will only be Granted by the PRINCIPAL or the DEPUTY PRINCIPAL.
- 8. English and Kiswahili are the two mediums of communication, use of 'sheng' is prohibited. Vernacular, abusive language and rudeness will not be condoned. Etiquette in conversations/discussions should be observed. Rowdy behaviour e.g. shouting, screaming and yelling in the school compound is not allowed.
- 9. No student will be allowed to talk to any visitor without permission from the office or the teacher on duty.
- 10.a) Every student will be expected to belong to not more than one club or society in operation within the school.
 - b) No club will be allowed to arrange for any outing without the knowledge of the patron.
 - c) Any money collected from members as subscription fees will have to be deposited in the school Accounts Office and a receipt issued against the deposit.
- 11. Cases of serious sicknesses, fire, fights, accidents etc will have to be reported at once to the teacher on duty or any other teacher available
- 12. Drinking alcohol, smoking or taking intoxicating drugs is strictly prohibited.
- 13.Dangerous implements like knives will not be kept or carried by any student while at school. Anybody found with such implements will be prosecuted.
- 14.Duty assigned to any student whether in class, dormitory, dining hall, compound or any Other place in the school will be expected to be done within the stipulated time and with minimal supervision.
 - Note all assignments given by the teachers should be completed on time and students should thoroughly prepare for examinations and other educational activity; copying or duplication of assignments is prohibited.
- 15. The school does not provide special diet
- 16. Every student will be expected to be quiet and in bed at 10.00p.m when lights shall be put off.
- 17. Students will be expected to be in school by 2.00p.m on all opening days. Any student Reporting after this time will be sent back home to bring the parent. No student should Report back on a weekend.
- 18. Any student who does not report to school on the official reporting date MUST be Accompanied by the parent/guardian. (We shall not accept young teenagers to be the Guardians). Only persons whose details are in the students file will be allowed to Address to matters affecting the girl.
- 19. All students will be expected to take good care of any school furniture/equipments

issued to them. If there is any careless destruction, the student will replace the spoilt item with a physical replacement of the same.

- 20. The following areas are out of bound for students; staffroom Kitchen and staff quarters.
- 21 Playing, idleness, noise making, staring, jeering and talking to visitors is a punishable offence by tidying the compound.
- 22. All school programmes are compulsory; these include preps, Sunday service, co-curricular activities, duties and communal work. Absenteeism from any is a punishable offence by tidying the compound.

PROHIBITED MATERIALS

- ➤ Radios/walkman
- ➤ Blow dryers
- ➤ Mobile phones/Sim cards/ Flash Disks/Memory Cards
- > Tongs
- > Water heater
- Alcohol and drugs
- > Iron box
- ➤ Knives.

Note: All the above shall be confiscated and the student shall be suspended.

OTHER RULES AND REGULATIONS

- ➤ Disrespect to teachers, non-teaching staff and to other students will not be condoned and is punishable by suspension
- > Bullying or any other form of discrimination is prohibited and shall lead to expulsion
- Involvement in any sexual immorality is a sin and is prohibited
- > Laziness will not be condoned
- ➤ No one should undermine school authority
- ➤ Make use of free time productively.
- Malingering to avoid tests, examinations or performance of duties will not be condoned
- > Stealing is an offence and not allowed in school. If one is apprehended one will be required to repay 5 times what she has stolen.
